

MAX FARM SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP GRANT (Application Process)

No formal application is provided for this grant. It is the applicants responsibility to prepare an application that is suitable. There are two items required of the applicant and they are:

Cover letter to include but not limited to:

- A. Name and pertinent information
- B. Extra curricular activities, clubs, sports, committees etc.
- C. Major course of study pursued in high school or freshman year of college, and approximate GPA
- D. Community involvement
- E. Other

Essay:

This essay should pertain to why you should be considered for this grant. Include such things as, school you plan to attend, course of study, aspirations, and where you see yourself five or ten years from now. Be creative and limit this essay to no more than three hundred words.

Any other pertinent information will be considered

Your application will be reviewed by a subcommittee of the Board of Directors of Max Farm Services and their decision as to who the recipient is will be final.
